PUBLIC ACTS, 1994 SESSION

NO. 148. AN ACT RELATING TO DIFFERENTIAL TAX RATES WITHIN
THE NORTH BENNINGTON GRADED SCHOOL DISTRICT.
(H.238)

It is hereby enacted by the General Assembly of the State of Vermont:

Sec. 1. 16 V.S.A. § 427(b) is amended to read:

(b) This subsection shall apply only to the Underhill incorporated school district and the North Bennington graded school district. If an incorporated school district includes more than one town within its district, or parts of more than one town within its district, the most recent equalized grand list shall be used to allocate the annual incorporated school district budget between the several parts of the incorporated district. Once the budget is allocated, the grand lists of each of the several parts, which are made up by different boards of listers, shall be used to set an individual tax rate for each of the parts within the incorporated school district. The commissioner of the department of taxes shall adopt all necessary rules and regulations to implement the provisions of this subsection.

Sec. 2. Sec. 2 of Act No. 261 of the Acts of the 1971 Adjourned Session of the Vermont General Assembly is amended to read:

Sec. 2. This act shall take effect from passage *[and subsection (b) shall be effective only with respect to the Underhill incorporated school district]*.

Sec. 3. EFFECTIVE DATE

This act shall take effect from passage.

NO. 149. AN ACT RELATING TO GREEN MOUNTAIN PASSPORTS.
(H.450)

It is hereby enacted by the General Assembly of the State of Vermont:

Sec. 1. 31 V.S.A. § 1002(b) and (c) are amended to read:
§ 1002. GREEN MOUNTAIN PASSPORT; ELIGIBILITY

* * *

(b) A Green Mountain Passport application shall be issued by the clerk of any town to a resident of that town who swears under oath that he or she meets the eligibility criteria established pursuant to subsection (a) of this section. A fee of \$2.00 will be charged at the time of application *[of which 50 cents will be retained by the town clerk and the remainder of the amount shall be forwarded with the application to the department of aging and disabilities to be used for the purposes of this program.]* and shall be retained by the town issuing the passport. The town clerk shall issue the actual passport. Records shall be maintained as prescribed by law. Statistical information shall be furnished to the commissioner upon request.

(c) Forms for the issuance of passports shall be prepared by the commissioner and provided in sufficient number by him or her to the clerk of each town. *[The town clerk shall complete the form with each applicant and shall submit the completed form to the commissioner who shall mail to each applicant the passport, which shall be a pocket-sized card, containing the name and address of the applicant, social security number, medical statistics and any other information as determined by the commissioner.]*

§ 1004. PRIVATE COOPERATION

*[(a) The secretary of the agency of human services may instruct the commissioner to make available to the passport
